## Korea's Clean Energy Collaboration priorities for CEM16/MI-10

- **Industry Decarbonization:** Promoting the use of carbon-free energy sources and technologies in the industrial sector to reduce emissions and enhance sustainability
- **Power Sector Transformation:** Scaling up the use of carbon-free energy in the power sector, including advancements in energy storage and grid modernization, aligning with Brazil's Power Sector Transformation Roundtable
- **Expanding Future Fuels:** Strengthening the role of hydrogen and other emerging clean fuels, building on discussions from the Unlocking Future Fuels Roundtable in Brazil
- **AI & Energy (Enhancing Efficiency and Demand Management):** Driving innovation in energy demand management and efficiency through AI technology, emphasizing the synergy between AI for Energy and Energy for AI to optimize energy systems and enhance grid resilience



# Expected objectives and outcomes from SOM/AG in preparation for the Ministerial



**Strengthen CEM/MI Platforms:** Align initiatives with G20/G7 and COP commitments.



**Drive Clean Energy Action:** Scale carbon-free technologies and AI-driven energy solutions.



**Foster Collaboration:** Align CEM/MI strategy with national energy priorities.



**Align with Global Priorities:** Connect CEM/MI to G20 and COP29/30 goals.



**Flagship Initiatives:** Highlight initiatives to drive action and collaboration.



## How CEM and MI communities can showcase their work at CEM16/MI-10

- **Showcase CEM/MI Impact:** Highlight concrete examples of how CEM and MI have accelerated domestic and international energy policy objectives.
- **Leverage CEM16/MI-10 in Asia region:** Launch new work to support clean energy transitions in the region, including in EMDEs (Emerging Markets and Developing Economies).
- **Strengthen Private Sector Partnerships:** Identify and announce public-private collaborations for clean energy transitions during co-location with the World Climate Expo.
- **Use CEM16/MI-10 as a critical milestone:** Leverage the CEM and MI communities to develop new initiatives in support of the global clean energy agenda (e.g. G20, COP30, etc.)
