

# Long-term energy scenarios for the clean energy transition

*A Campaign associated with the Multilateral Solar and Wind Working Group (MSWWG)*

This campaign is expected to last 12 months, with a possibility of being multi-year subject to CEM Member support.

## Goals

The campaign is to promote the wider adoption and improved use of long-term model-based energy scenarios by: (1) sharing country experience in the use and benefits of energy scenario modelling for national and regional policy planning; (2) showcasing innovative tools and methods for energy scenario modelling that address the integration challenges of variable renewable energy (VRE); and (3) identifying channels to build capacity for clean energy transition planning in countries with limited experience.
