

Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage (CCUS) Initiative

Goals

This initiative strengthens the framework for public-private collaboration on CCUS, while complementing the efforts and adding coordinated value beyond the activities of existing organizations and initiatives such as the Carbon Sequestration Leadership Forum (CSLF), International Energy Agency (IEA), IEA Greenhouse Gas R&D Programme (IEAGHG), Mission Innovation (MI), and Global CCS Institute (GCCSI). The objective of this initiative is to accelerate CCUS as a viable CO₂ mitigation option; facilitate diffusion of knowledge on technologies, regulations, and policies; and lead to strategic partnerships to accelerate both near and longer-term investment in CCUS to advance global deployment by making it more competitive. A key CEM advantage is that, because of its cross-cutting portfolio, outcomes from this CCUS initiative are placed firmly in the context of broader clean energy strategies.
